#### **Background**

Throughout the last two years of World History, students have examined major trends in politics, economics, religion, society, art, and culture. Students will now apply this information into a projection of the future. Taking what they have learned about factors that are shaping the modern world, students will create what they believe an issue of *Time* magazine will look like in the year 2050.

#### **Objectives**

Students will understand major trends in the modern world. Students will apply this knowledge by making educated predictions of future events. Students will demonstrate the ability to collaborate in a group. Students will learn to present information in a clear, concise way.

#### **Procedure**

1. With your group, brainstorm possible stories on a variety of different topics. It may be helpful to view a current issue of *Time* magazine to learn more about the types of topics it addresses. Be sure to include a wide variety of topics.
2. Decide which students will be responsible for each section of the magazine. Designate who will write each of the stories. Use as accurate of information as possible. When necessary, reference data from the current year
3. When possible, include drawings, charts, or other visual aids with stories.
4. Students may also choose to create advertisements, cartoons, letters to the editor, and other non-news parts of the magazine.
5. Compile all the information into a common format.
6. Keep in mind that the magazine will be graded on believability, plausibility, and recognition of current trends that will impact the world tremendously.

#### **Artifact**

Students will work together to compile a mock issue of *Time* magazine for the year 2050.
